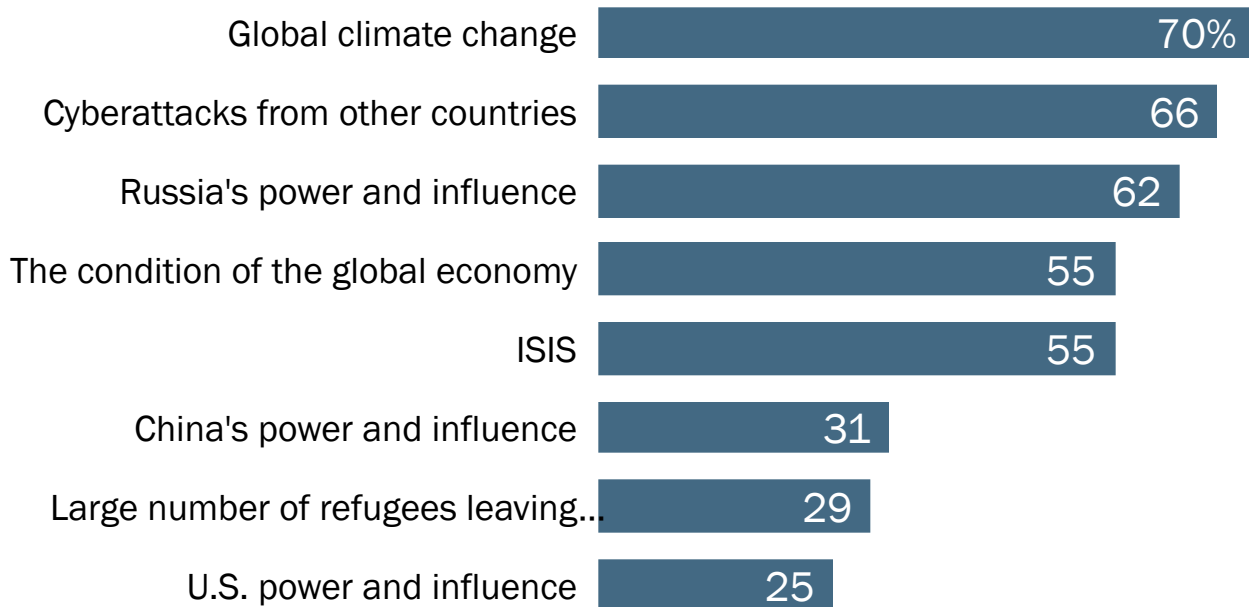

Climate Change, Cyberattacks Seen as Greatest Threats

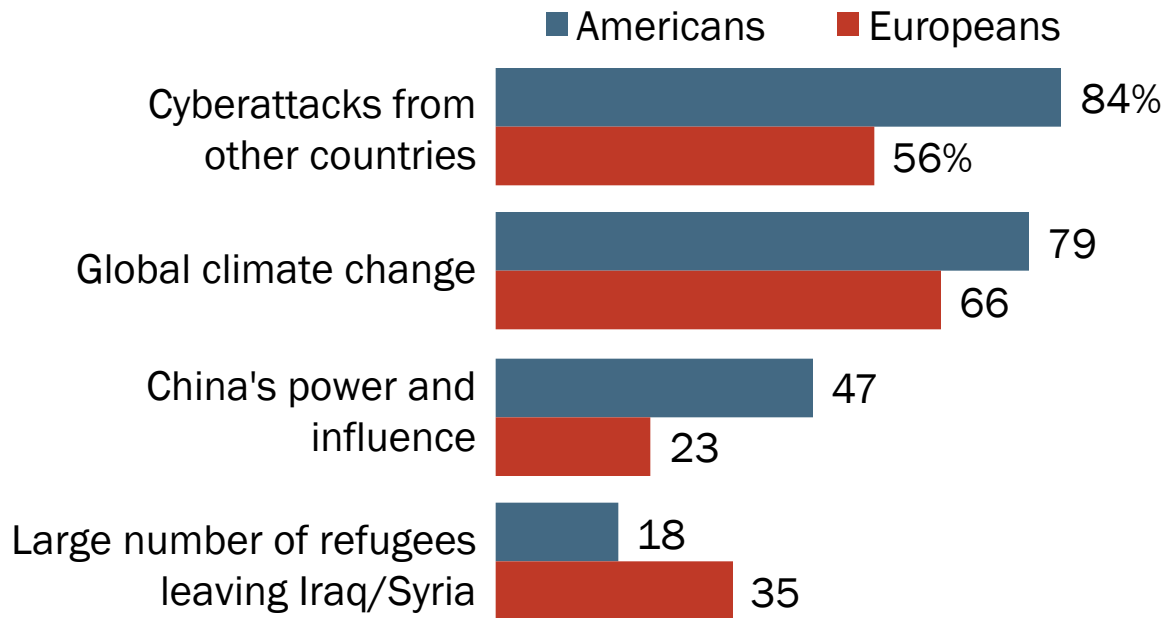
% saying each is a major threat to their country

% saying each is a major threat to their country

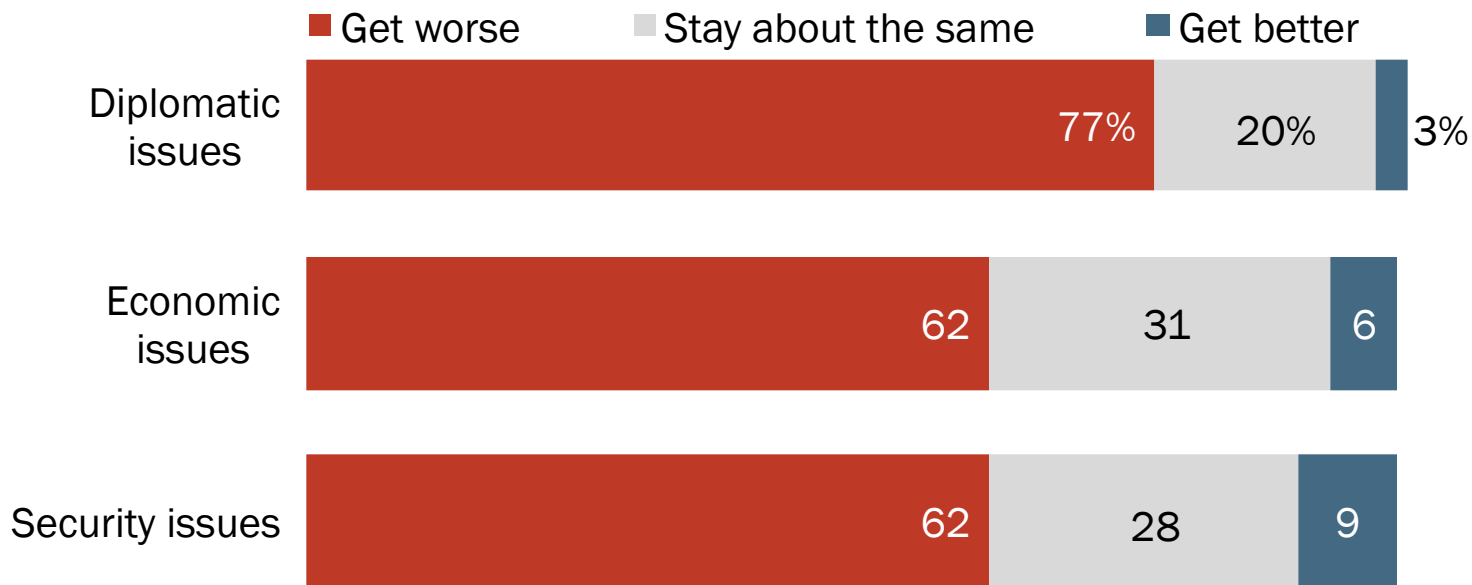

Transatlantic Relations Expected to Worsen

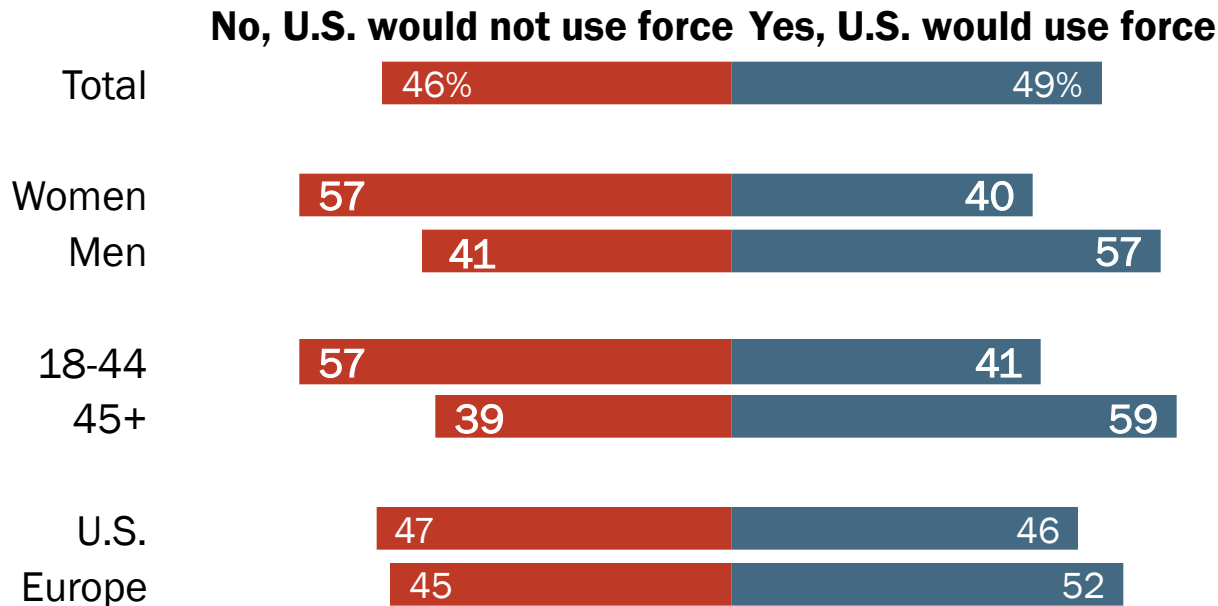
Over the next 12 months, do you think that relations between Europe and the U.S. will get better, get worse or stay about the same when it comes to ...

If Russia got into a serious military conflict with one of its neighboring countries that is a NATO ally, do you think the United States would or would not use military force to defend that country?

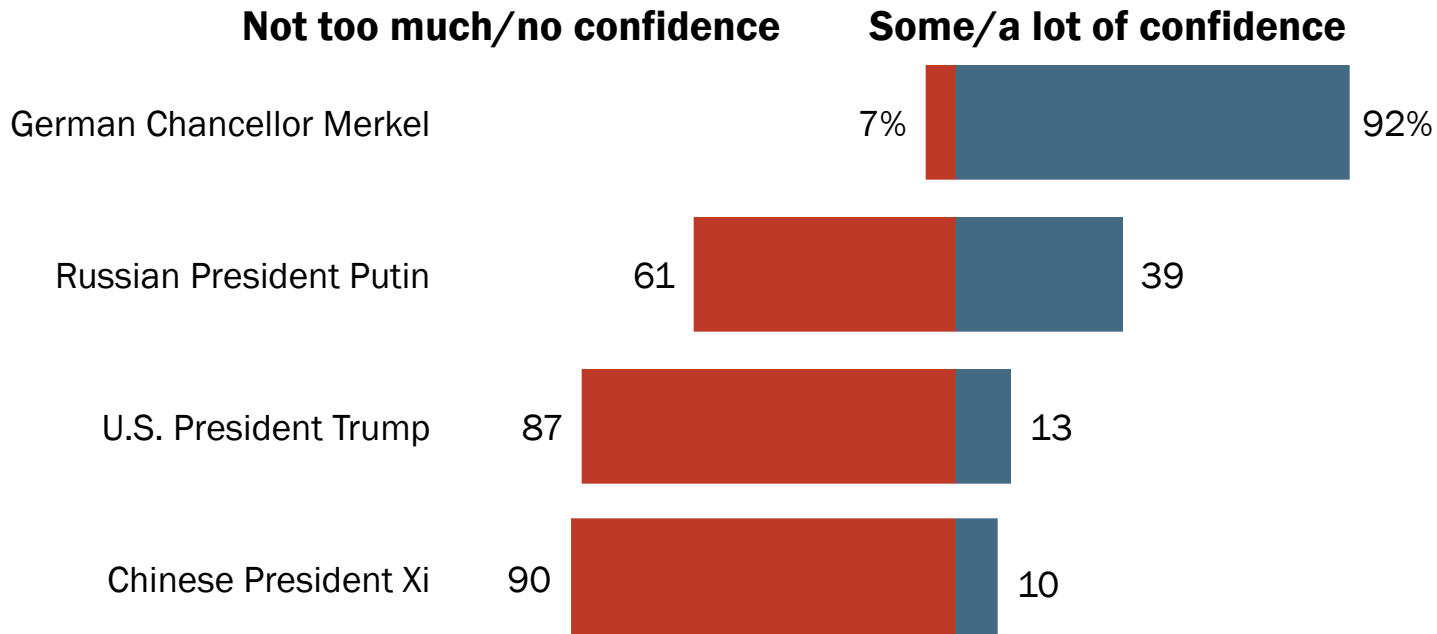

Confidence in Merkel Far Outpaces Trust in Trump, Other Leaders

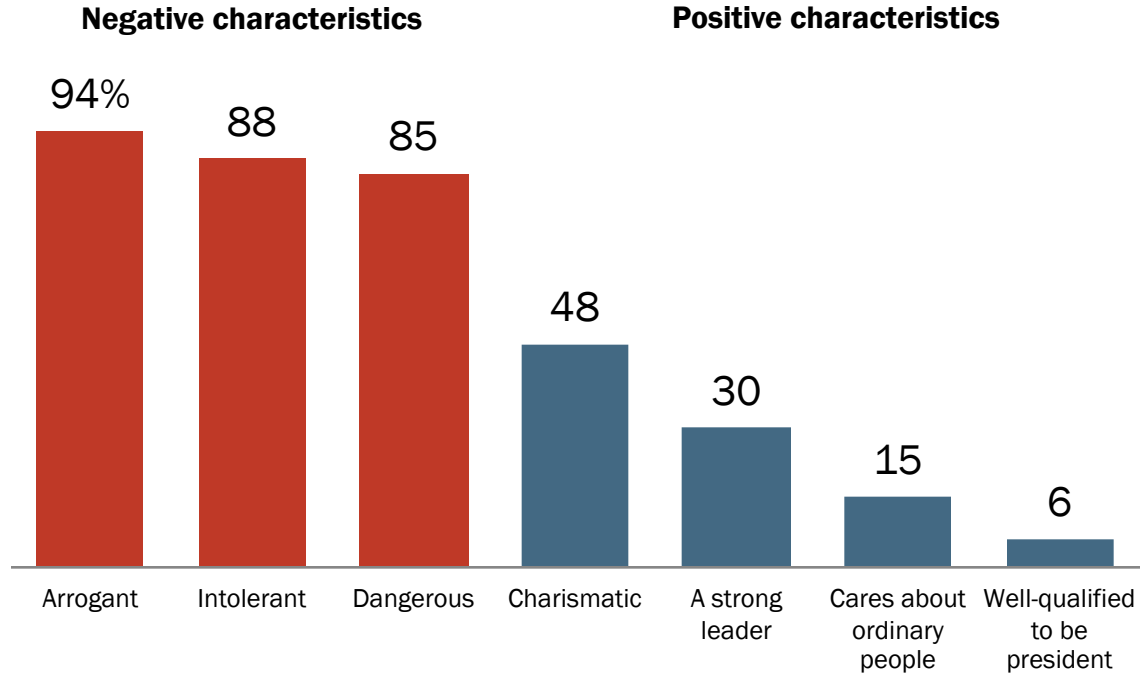
How much confidence do you have in __ to do the right thing regarding world affairs?
